### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to protecting the rights of custodial and other non-teaching employees of school districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 59B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter", in line 36, the following words:-;
- 3 provided, however, that the hiring, promotion and termination of employees in custodial,
- 4 maintenance and other non-teaching positions shall be conducted in accordance with any
- 5 governing collective bargaining agreement.
