#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act protecting the rights of custodial and other non-teaching employees of school districts.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 59B of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by inserting after the word "chapter", in lines 13 and 14, the following
- 3 words:-; provided, however, that in case of custodial, maintenance and other non-teaching
- 4 positions, the hiring, promotion and termination of such employees shall be conducted in
- 5 accordance with chapter 31 if such positions are classified as civil service positions or in
- 6 accordance with any governing collective bargaining agreement.
