## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to group insurance costs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6 of chapter 32A of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting the
- 2 following new sentence: For active and retired employees, their dependents and the survivors
- 3 of deceased employees, including municipal subscribers, the maximum amount of deductibles
- 4 and copayments for covered services during an enrollment year in a plan shall not exceed \$2,000
- 5 for individual coverage and \$4,000 for family coverage.
