### The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act relative to police pursuits.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 25 of Chapter 90 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition by adding to the end of said section 25 the following:-
- Any person who, while operating or in charge of a motor vehicle, when being pursued by
- 4 a police officer in an official police vehicle displaying lights and siren, shall refuse or neglect to
- 5 stop, shall be punished by a fine of not less than two thousand dollars nor more than ten thousand
- 6 dollars or imprisonment in State Prison for not less than thirty days nor more than two and one-
- 7 half years, or both such fine and imprisonment.
