- 1 Resolved,
- 2 That the Department of Revenue in conjunction with the House and Senate Joint
- 3 Committee on Revenue shall conduct a study of the decline of the recreational fishery with
- 4 particular emphasis on the striped bass and the concurrent impact on the revenues of the
- 5 Commonwealth. Said study shall be completed by December 15, 2013 and be forwarded to the
- 6 Division of Marine Fisheries and to the clerks of the Senate and House of Representatives. The
- 7 report shall include, but not be limited to, recommendations to enhance the revenue generating
- 8 capacity of the recreational fishery.
