Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The Executive Office of Consumer Protection and Business Regulation
- 2 shall conduct a study in conjunction with the Attorney General's Office Division of Consumer
- 3 Protection to determine a method of posting freshness expiration dates on all consumer products
- 4 with such dates in a uniform, clear and conspicuous manner. Said study shall be completed no
