By Mr. Downing, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1473) of Benjamin B. Downing and Marjorie C. Decker for legislation relative to retaliatory taxation by life insurance companies. Revenue.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to retaliatory taxation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 20 of chapter 63 of the General Laws is hereby amended by
- 2 inserting after the third paragraph the following paragraph:-
- 3 Domestic life insurers which pay retaliatory taxes to other jurisdictions may claim a
- 4 credit against the tax imposed by this section. The amount of the credit shall be 15% of any
- 5 retaliatory tax liability incurred pursuant to the laws of any other state in which the life insurer
- 6 transacts business. The amount of the credit shall increase 5% per annual filing, until reaching
- 7 50% of any retaliatory tax liability.
- 8 SECTION 2. Section one shall apply with respect to taxable years beginning January 1,
- 9 2015.
