Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the Norfolk County
- 2 retirement board may, in accordance with guidelines established by the public employee
- 3 retirement administration commission, purchase an appropriate real property located within
- 4 Norfolk County to use for the administrative office of the Norfolk County retirement system and
- 5 may purchase or lease equipment and employ any personnel as necessary for the proper
- 6 administration and transaction of the business of the retirement system.
