Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 6 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting in line 31 after the word "compensation" the
- 7 following words," in the event that such person retires in accordance with this section any
- 8 secondary cancer shall be covered in accordance with section 9 of this chapter."
