An Act to create property tax credits for individuals with disabilities..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (k) of section 6 of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2008 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the  
3 following new paragraph:-

4 (10) Notwithstanding the age restriction imposed in paragraph 2 of this subsection,  
5 individuals eligible for social security supplemental income due to a disability and that otherwise  
6 meet the requirements of this section, may claim the credit.
