An Act relative to the advertisement of motor fuel.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 295D of Chapter 94 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking  
2 it in its entirety and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3 Section 295D. Any advertisement of motor fuel other than those required in  
4 section 295C shall display the total price including all taxes.
