**In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court  
(2015-2016)**

An Act relative to a municipality’s right of first refusal of agricultural land.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 61A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in lines 63, 82, 124 and 141 by striking out the number  
3 “120” and inserting in place thereof the following number:- 180.

4 SECTION 2. Said section is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 37, the figure  
5 “90” and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- 120.

6 SECTION 3. The twenty-third paragraph of said section is hereby amended by adding the  
7 following sentence:- The city or town shall not be required to exercise the option to purchase any  
8 property not classified under this chapter.

9 SECTION 4. The twelfth paragraph of said section is hereby amended by adding the  
10 following sentence:- The landowner shall respond no later than 30 days after having received the  
11 purchase and sale contract.

SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
