An Act relative to equitable treatment for substance use disorders.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 6 of Chapter 64H of the General Laws, as so appearing, is hereby  
2 amended by striking out, in lines 71 to 72, the words “sixty-four F and one hundred and thirty-  
3 eight” and inserting in place thereof the following words:- and sixty-four F.
