An Act relative to the retirement of MassPort officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby further amended by inserting in the description of Group 4 in  
3   paragraph (g) of subdivision (2), in line 68, after the words fire control men; the following:-

4           "employees of the Massachusetts Port Authority who are employed as port officers and  
5   supervisors of said employees who shall include port sergeants, lieutenants, captains, assistant  
6   chiefs, deputy chiefs, and director;"
