In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to a municipality's right of first refusal of agricultural land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 61A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended in lines 63, 82, 124 and 141 by striking out the number
- 3 "120" and inserting in place thereof the following number:- 180.
- 4 SECTION 2. Said section is hereby further amended by striking out, in line 37, the figure
- 5 "90" and inserting in place thereof the following figure:- 120.
- 6 SECTION 3. The twenty-third paragraph of said section is hereby amended by adding the
- 7 following sentence:- The city or town shall not be required to exercise the option to purchase any
- 8 property not classified under this chapter.

- 9 SECTION 4. The twelfth paragraph of said section is hereby amended by adding the
- 10 following sentence:- The landowner shall respond no later than 30 days after having received the
- 11 purchase and sale contract.
- 12 SECTION 5. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
