An Act prohibiting fundraising receptions during budget deliberations \Box .

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 55 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after
- 2 section 14 the following new section:--
- 3 "Section 14A. Fundraising receptions prohibited during budget floor debate.
- 4 No political committee organized or operating on behalf of a member of the General
- 5 Court, or any other political committee controlled by a member of the General Court, shall hold a
- 6 fundraising reception or other fundraising event during the time the state budget is debated on
- 7 the floor of the chamber in which the member serves or one week prior to said debate or one
- 8 week following. This section shall not apply to debates on any supplemental budgets.

- 9 Contributions collected in violation of this section shall be returned to the contributor and
- 10 the member referred to the Ethics Committee of the chamber in which the member serves for
- 11 sanction."
