RESOLVE establishing a commission to enhance competitiveness in plastics manufacturing

Resolved,

- that a special commission is hereby established to study the availability of safe, cost-
- 2 effective alternatives to bisphenol-A (BPA) in plastics manufacturing. The commission shall
- 3 consist of five members as follows: the director of the office of technical assistance or his
- 4 designee, the commissioner of the department of public health or his designee, the director of the
- 5 Massachusetts office of business development or his designee, the director of the Massachusetts
- 6 manufacturing extension partnership or his designee, and a representative of the toxics use
- 7 reduction institute at the University of Massachusetts Lowell.
- 8 The commission shall sponsor an open exchange with plastics manufacturers in the
- 9 Commonwealth and examine the costs and benefits of implementing available alternatives. The
- 10 commission?s study shall include, but not be limited to, the cost of implementing alternatives,
- 11 the potential of directing existing financial incentives including state and federal grants and tax
- 12 credits toward the implementation of safer alternative in plastics manufacturing, or the need for
- 13 new incentives to be developed. The recommendations and findings shall be filed with the clerks

- 14 of the House and Senate, the chairs of the joint committee on the environment, natural resources
- 15 and agriculture and the chairs of the joint committee on public health no later than June 1, 2012.
