An Act prohibiting the sale of lottery tickets on credit.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 29 of chapter 10 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2012  
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after line 8 the following new paragraph:-

3           No licensed agent may sell a ticket or share if the only consideration given is a promise,  
4 in fact or in law, to make payment at a future time, or is payment by credit card.
