By Ms. Creem, a petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1622) of Cynthia S. Creem and John V. Fernandes for legislation to create a sunset advisory commission. State Administration and Regulatory Oversight.

The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act to create a sunset advisory commission.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. There shall be a Sunset Advisory Commission consisting of 3 members of
- 2 the senate, 1 of whom shall be appointed by the minority leader of the senate, 3 members of the
- 3 house, 1 of whom shall be appointed by the minority leader of the house of representatives, and 2
- 4 members appointed by the governor, one of whom shall have experience working with the
- 5 Boards and Commission Office. Commission members shall serve for a two year term.
- 6 The Sunset Advisory Commission shall conduct a review of all commissions and boards
- 7 that were created by any act, resolve or statute of the commonwealth or by executive order. The
- 8 review shall examine the membership information, mission, goals, and objectives of all
- 9 commissions and make recommendations, if any, to improve the efficiency or transparency of
- 10 each board or commission. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall also make recommendations
- as to which commissions should be dissolved because they have accomplished the goals and
- 12 responsibilities for which they were created, or because those goals and responsibilities are

- 13 duplicative of another commission. The Sunset Advisory Commission shall also make findings
- 14 concerning those commissions (1) that have more than one-third of membership seats vacant; (2)
- 15 that have not had a meeting in more than a year; or (3) that have not able to obtain a quorum for
- 16 more than a year.
- 17 The commission shall file a report of its findings and recommendations with the senate
- 18 and house clerks and with the governor not later than March 1, 2016.
