Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 89 of the General Laws is hereby amended by striking out, in lines $8-9$, the words "use all or part of an adjacent lane if it is safe to do so or wait for" and inserting in place thereof the following words:-
