Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby 2 amended by inserting after section 5J the following new section:-

Section 5J 1/2. A city or town, by adoption of an ordinance or by-law, may establish a special assessment policy for the substantial rehabilitation of historic agricultural structures listed in the state register of historic places, either individually or as contributing elements within an

6 historic district. For such properties, the increase in assessed value resulting from such

rehabilitation shall be phased in one-fifth increments over a period of five years to the full

assessed value of the property; provided, however, that the rehabilitation shall meet the standards

of the Massachusetts historical commission in order to be eligible for the phased in special

10 assessment; and provided further, that the secretary of the commonwealth, as chairman of the

11	Massachusetts historical commission, shall promulgate applicable rules and regulations to carry
12	out the provisions of this section.
