Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 164 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2000 Official

2 Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

3 Section 70B. The Department of Telecommunications and Energy shall require local

4 distribution companies to survey their gas piping system for leak detection. Upon finding a

5 natural gas leak, the leak must be investigated, graded and monitored. The surveying,

6 investigating, grading and monitoring of these leaks shall be done by employees of local

7 distribution companies and reported to the Department of Telecommunications and Energy.
