**The Commonwealth of Massachusetts**

**In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court  
(2021-2022)**

An Act relative to retirement classification.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2018 Official Edition, is  
2 hereby amended by inserting after the words "wayward children" the following words:- "or  
3 employees of the Commonwealth and those eligible Cambridge Health Alliance/Cambridge  
4 Hospital employees whose regular and major duties require them to provide treatment for, or be  
5 responsible for, the care of persons who are mentally ill, intellectually or developmentally  
6 disabled, chronically psychologically impaired or who are persons with chronic infectious  
7 disease; or registered nurses and other health care professions that are state employees or those  
8 eligible Cambridge Health Alliance/Cambridge Hospital employees in a professional status for  
9 the purposes of their retirement."
