3 (c) (1) Nothing in this section shall prohibit any seller from offering a discount for the

4 purchase of gas to a buyer to induce such buyer to pay by cash, debit card, check or similar

5 means rather than by credit card, provided the discount is offered to all prospective buyers and

6 the availability of the discount is clearly and conspicuously disclosed.

- 7 (2) Any provision in any contract or agreement prohibiting a retailer or distributor from
- 8 offering such discount is void and without effect as contrary to public policy.
