*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 34B of Chapter 138 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting, in line 13, after the words “chapter ninety” the  
3   following words:— , or a valid photographic, non-duplicate motor vehicle license issued by the  
4   registry or department of motor vehicles of another state
