## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act relative to placing the word "veteran" on any eligible driver's license..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the registry of  
2 motor vehicles is required to list the word "Veteran" in any way they deem appropriate on any  
3 driver's license in which the applicant is a veteran as defined in the forty-third clause of section  
4 seven of chapter four.
