Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the registry of
- 2 motor vehicles is required to list the word "Veteran" in any way they deem appropriate on any
- 3 driver's license in which the applicant is a veteran as defined in the forty-third clause of section
- 4 seven of chapter four.
