*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

3           SECTION 1. Chapter 17 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
4           is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new section:-

5           7B. The department shall establish, conduct and maintain an annual program of education  
6           and training for members of local boards of health; provided, however, that the department shall  
7           consult with the Massachusetts Association of Boards of Health in the development of said  
8           program; provided, further, that the department may contract with the Massachusetts Association  
9           of Boards of Health to provide such education and training. All education and training courses  
10          shall be free of charge to board members and, to the extent practicable, be offered in various  
11          locations throughout the commonwealth.

12 SECTION 2. Chapter 21A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official  
13 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after section fifteen the following new section:-

14 15A. The department of environmental protection shall establish, conduct and maintain  
15 an annual program of education and training for members of local conservation commissions;  
16 provided, however, that the department shall consult with the Massachusetts Association of  
17 Conservation Commissions in the development of said program; provided, further, that the  
18 department may contract with the Massachusetts Association of Conservation Commissions to  
19 provide such education and training. All education and training courses shall be free of charge to  
20 commission members and, to the extent practicable, be offered in various locations throughout  
21 the commonwealth.

22 SECTION 3. Section 3 of chapter 23B of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
23 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new  
24 subsection:-

25 (w) establish, conduct and maintain an annual program of education and training for  
26 members of local planning boards and zoning boards of appeals; provided, however that the  
27 department shall consult with the Massachusetts Federation of Planning and Appeals Boards  
28 regarding in development of said program; provided, further, the department may contract with  
29 the Massachusetts Citizen Planning Training Collaborative at the University of Massachusetts to  
30 provide such education and training. All education and training courses shall be free of charge to  
31 board members and, to the extent practicable, be offered in various locations throughout the  
32 commonwealth.
