In the One Hundred and Ninety-Second General Court (2021-2022)

An Act relative to the guaranty fund for home improvement contractors.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 1 of Chapter 142A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out lines 6-11 inclusive and inserting in place
- 3 thereof the following -
- 4 "Claimant" an owner and resident of a residential building, containing at least one but not
- 5 more than four dwelling units, who has entered into a construction contract with a contractor to
- 6 carry out construction work on said building, or, an owner and resident of a single condominium
- 7 unit in a residential building, who has entered into a construction contract with a contractor to
- 8 carry out construction work on an area of said building under that owner's exclusive control, and
- 9 who is making a claim against said contractor for failure of performance under said contract.
