In the One Hundred and Eighty-Ninth General Court (2015-2016)

An Act relative to water meter testing fees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. The first sentence of section 39I of chapter 40 of the General Laws, as
- 2 appearing in the 2012 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words "rate for
- 3 such quarter or", in line 5, the following word:- "billing"; and said section 39I is hereby further
- 4 amended in the third sentence by striking out, in lines 12-14, the words "and in no case shall the
- 5 expense so required to be paid exceed three dollars for each examination and test"; and said
- 6 section 39I is hereby further amended in said sentence by striking out, in line 15, the words "two
- 7 per cent of accuracy" and inserting in place thereof the following words:- "American Water
- 8 Works Association (AWWA) accuracy standards".
