## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act Transportation and Housing Provider and Member Policy Act.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1 Emergency Preamble-

2 "Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is

3 forthwith to consolidate time and expense involved in the administration of Transportation and

4 Housing Policy Programs, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for

5 the immediate preservation of the public convenience."

6 Transportation and Housing Provider and Member Policy Act Trust and its appointed

7 commissioner is authorized to provide unused and unlimited treasury notes by the treasury on an

- 8 ongoing basis for the following facilities and services:
- 9 Policy to Provide unlimited access, coverage and accommodations to develop and
  10 administer

- 11 Transportation and Housing Provider and Member Policy Programs for applicants
- 12 seeking Full Cost Coverage, No Premium and No Co-Pay options and enrollment.
- 13 To be signed into law before May 1,2017 and to take effect on June 1, 2017 [\$unlimited]
