Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The bridge on Park Street, in the West Roxbury section of the city of Boston, shall be
- 2 designated and known as The Honorable Francis X. Coppinger Bridge in honor of Francis X.
- 3 Coppinger who served in the Massachusetts House of Representatives for the Tenth Suffolk
- 4 District. The Massachusetts Highway Department shall erect and maintain suitable markers
- 5 bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
