An Act relative to correct inequities regarding the retirement of state-employed and special authority-employed police officers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in line 253, the words "University of
- 3 Massachusetts police".
- 4 SECTION 2. Section 3 of said chapter 32, as so appearing, is hereby amended by striking
- 5 out the words "chief of security for the University of Massachusetts medical school of
- 6 supervising agent", in lines 322 through 324, and inserting in place thereof the following words:-
- 7 "University of Massachusetts, Massport police, and state university and community college
- 8 police."
