- 4 In the course of its investigation and study, the department shall review reports filed
- 5 under section 12B of chapter 76 of the General Laws, gather information from other sources,
- 6 including the parent information system and the school choice transportation reimbursement
- 7 program established under said section 12B.
- 8 The department shall report to the general court the results of its investigation and study
- and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its
- 10 recommendations into effect by filing the same with the clerk of the senate on or before the first
- 11 Wednesday of April 2010.
