Senate, June 20, 2013 - Reported (in part) by the Senate (Ways and Means) on House Bill making appropriations for fiscal year 2013 to provide for supplementing certain existing appropriations and for certain other activities and projects (House, No. 3522).

In the Year Two Thousand Thirteen
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An Act making appropriations for the fiscal year 2013 to provide for supplementing certain existing appropriations and for certain other activities and projects.

Whereas, the deferred operation of this act would tend to defeat its purpose, which is to provide forthwith for improvements to the department of transitional assistance in the commonwealth, therefore, it is hereby declared to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. To provide for supplementing certain items in the general appropriation act and
2 other appropriation acts for fiscal year 2013, the sums set forth in section 2 are hereby
3 appropriated from the General Fund unless specifically designated otherwise in this act or in
4 those appropriation acts, for the several purposes and subject to the conditions specified in this
5 act or in those appropriation acts and subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public
6 funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. These sums shall be in addition to any amounts
7 previously appropriated and made available for the purposes of those items.

40 SECTION 2A. To provide for certain unanticipated obligations of the commonwealth, to
41 provide for an alteration of purpose for current appropriations and to meet certain requirements
42 of law, the sum set forth in this section is hereby appropriated from the General Fund unless
43 specifically designated otherwise in this section, for the several purposes and subject to the
44 conditions specified in this section and subject to the laws regulating the disbursement of public
45 funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2013. This sum shall be in addition to any amounts
46 previously appropriated and made available for the purposes of this item.

52 SECTION 2C.I. For the purpose of making available in fiscal year 2014 balances of
53 appropriations which otherwise would revert on June 30, 2013, the unexpended balance of the
54 maintenance appropriations listed below, not to exceed the amount specified below for each
55 item, is hereby re-appropriated for the purposes of and subject to the conditions stated for the
56 corresponding item in section 2 of the general appropriation act for fiscal year 2013; provided,
57 however, that for items which do not appear in said section 2 of said general appropriation act,
58 the amount in this section is re-appropriated for the purposes of and subject to the conditions
59 stated for the corresponding item in section 2 or 2A of this act or in prior appropriation acts. The
60 amount in this section is re-appropriated from the funds designated for the corresponding item in
61 said section 2 of said general appropriation act; provided, however, that for items which do not
62 appear in said section 2 of said general appropriation act, the amount in this section is re-
63 appropriated from the funds designated for the corresponding item in section 2 or 2A of this act
64 or in prior appropriation acts. The sum re-appropriated in this section shall be in addition to any
65 amounts available for such purposes.

69 SECTION 3. Item 1599-2013 of section 2A of chapter 142 of the acts of 2011 is hereby amended
70 by inserting after the figure “3:10-CV30073” the following words:- or other cases involving the
71 department of children and families.

72 SECTION 4. Item 8910-1000 of section 2 of chapter 139 of the acts of 2012 is hereby amended
73 by striking out the figure “\$2,396,673”, each time it appears, and inserting in place thereof the
74 following figure:- \$2,496,673.

75 SECTION 5. Item 8910-0188 of said section 2 of said chapter 139 is hereby amended by striking
76 out the figure “\$2,100,000”, each time it appears, and inserting in place thereof the following
77 figure:- \$2,225,000.

78 SECTION 6. Item 8910-8810 of said section 2 of said chapter 139 is hereby amended by
79 striking out the figure “\$8,000,000”, each time it appears, and inserting in place thereof the
80 following figure:- \$8,850,000.

81 SECTION 7. Item 1599-0054 of section 2A of chapter 3 of the acts of 2013 is hereby amended
82 by adding the following words:- ; and provided further, that any funds unexpended in fiscal year
83 2013 shall not revert and shall be made available for the purposes of this item until June 30, 2014

84 SECTION 8. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the unexpended
85 balances of all capital accounts which otherwise would revert on June 30, 2013 but which are
86 necessary to fund obligations during fiscal year 2014 are hereby re-authorized. This re-
87 authorization shall terminate upon enactment of a capital account extension law.

88 SECTION 9. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary and in recognition of the
89 heroic measures taken by Sean Allen Collier to protect the public safety of the citizens of the
90 commonwealth, who was sworn as a special state police officer under section 63 of chapter 22C
91 of the General Laws and as a deputy sheriff of Middlesex and Suffolk counties, the state
92 retirement board shall issue a killed in the line of duty death benefit to the family of officer Sean
93 Allen Collier under section 100A of chapter 32 of the General Laws. The state retirement board
94 shall administer the benefit according to terms and conditions established for benefits provided
95 under said section 100A of said chapter 32.

96 SECTION 10. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the state secretary
97 shall transfer \$716,511 from the elections division operating account in item 0521-0000 to the
98 HAVA Trust Account in item 0521-0700 in order to meet federal matching fund requirement
