Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of Article 97 of the Constitution of the
- 2 Commonwealth of Massachusetts, or any general or special law to the contrary, the Conservation
- 3 Commission of the Town of North Andover to grant to the Town of North Andover Board of
- 4 Selectmen a permanent easement upon the land shown as "Easement 1" and "Easement 2" on
- 5 Plan entitled "Easement Plan, Rea's Pond Pumping Station, Great Pond Road, North Andover,
- 6 Massachusetts," dated March 8, 2013, Scale 1"= 50', drawn by Merrill Associates, Inc.,
- 7 Hanover, MA, which land is currently under the care, custody and control of the Conservation
- 8 Commission, to be used for the use and replacement of the existing sewerage pump station and
- 9 contiguous sewer lines, manholes, conduits and other appurtenances associated with the
- 10 operation of the sewer system known as the Great Pond Road pumping station.
