An Act designating March as Fibromuscular Dysplasia Awareness Month.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 6 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 15XXXXX  
2 the following section:-

3 Section 15YYYYY. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the  
4 month of March as Fibromuscular Dysplasia Awareness Month and recommending that the  
5 month be observed in an appropriate manner by the people.
