## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninety-First General Court (2019-2020)

An Act commemorating first landing day.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 6 is hereby amended by adding after section 15CCCCCC the following new
- 2 section:-
- 3 Section 15DDDDDD. The governor shall annually issue a proclamation setting apart the
- 4 second Saturday in November as First Landing Day to honor the pilgrims that sailed aboard the
- 5 Mayflower and made landfall on what is now the Town of Provincetown, and their subsequent
- 6 exploration of environs in what is now the Town of Truro and the Town of Eastham, and to
- further honor the native peoples who inhabited what is now Barnstable County at contact, and
- 8 recommending that said day be observed by the people in an appropriate manner.
