## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

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**In the Year Two Thousand Eleven**  
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An Act to establish the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts Capital Maintenance Trust Fund and the Soldiers Home in Holyoke Capital Maintenance Trust Fund..

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 115A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2008 Official  
2 Edition, shall be amended by inserting the following new section:

3 Section 12. There shall be established on the books of the commonwealth separate funds  
4 to be known as the Soldiers' Home in Massachusetts Capital Maintenance Trust Fund and the  
5 Soldiers' Home in Holyoke Capital Maintenance Trust Fund. Said funds shall consist of federal  
6 reimbursements recovered or collected from any and all capital improvement projects at the  
7 Soldiers' Homes. Any amounts received from any appropriation, grant, gift, bequest or other

8 contribution explicitly made to said funds, and any income derived from the investment of  
9 amounts credited to said funds. The amounts so received shall be credited and invested by the  
10 treasurer of the commonwealth and held in trust by the secretary of health and human services.  
11 Amounts expended from said funds shall not be subject to further appropriation, and shall not  
12 exceed the amount earned in interest and other income derived from the investment of the  
13 principle amount credited to said fund. Any expenditure from said funds shall be at the direction  
14 of said secretary solely for the purposes of capital maintenance at said Soldiers' Homes. No  
15 expenditure from said funds shall be made for any direct or indirect costs associated with  
16 personnel.

17         The secretary shall file, with the House and Senate committees on Ways and Means not  
18 later than September first of each fiscal year, an annual financial plan of the projected revenues  
19 and expenditures for the ensuing fiscal year. All revenues credited to and expenditures made  
20 from such funds shall be reported, by subsidiary, on the Massachusetts management accounting  
21 and reporting system.
