An Act relative to workers compensation for veterans..

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- Section 1(7A) of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006 Official
- 2 Edition, is hereby amended by inserting at the end of the paragraph in line 159 the following:-
- 3 "Any employee who served in the United States Armed Forces or National Guard and as a result
- 4 of such service sustained an emotional or physical injury, who in the course of an arising out of
- 5 this employment receives a personal injury which combines with, or is aggravated or prolonged
- 6 by such disability, shall be entitled to compensation regardless of the extent to which the services
- 7 related disability contributes."
