Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 6(e) of chapter 62 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2020
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by replacing the words "one thousand five hundred dollars"
- 3 with the following words:- "fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000)."
