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AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE REGISTRY OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 14 of Chapter 36 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2006
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the last sentence and inserting the following:
- 3 "No deed or instrument shall be considered to have been received by the Register or left for record until
- 4 said deed or instrument has been approved for recording by the register and an instrument number or
- 5 document number or book and page has been assigned to said deed or instrument"
