An Act relative to the safe use of electronic devices by children.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 93 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 114 the  
2 following new section:-

3 Section 115. All mobile telephones sold or leased at a point of sale or retail establishment  
4 in the commonwealth shall clearly and conspicuously disclose, on product packaging, the  
5 following notice to consumers:-

6 "To assure safety, the Federal Government requires that cell phones meet radio frequency  
7 (RF) exposure guidelines. If you carry or use your phone in a pocket or the phone is otherwise in  
8 contact with your body when the phone is on and connected to a wireless network, you may

9 exceed the federal guidelines for exposure to RF radiation. Refer to the instructions in your  
10 phone or user manual for information about how to use your phone safely."
