An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Norwood as the Thomas J. Kewriga Memorial Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Bridge N-25-003 on Morse Street in the Town of Norwood, spanning the  
2 Neponset River, shall be designated and known as the “Thomas J. Kewriga Memorial Bridge” in  
3 recognition of Thomas J. Kewriga, a beloved resident of Norwood, who passed away on August  
4 1, 2013 and who previously worked as engineer on a project to reconstruct the bridge at issue.  
5 The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker  
6 bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
