By Mr. Brewer, petition (accompanied by bill, Senate, No. 1873) of Gobi and Brewer (by vote of the town) for legislation to combine the positions of treasurer-collector and tax collector into one position in the town of Barre [Local Approval Received] [Joint Committee on Municipalities and Regional Government].

#### The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year Two Thousand Eleven

An Act providing for the appointment of a treasurer-collector in the town of Barre.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law or rule or regulation to the contrary,
- 2 there shall be a treasurer-collector for the town of Barre. The treasurer-collector shall have all
- 3 the powers, perform the duties and be subject to the liabilities and penalties now or hereafter
- 4 conferred and imposed by law on town treasurers and town collectors of taxes. The treasurer-
- 5 collector shall be appointed and may be removed by a majority vote of the board of selectmen of
- 6 the town. The board of selectmen shall appoint a treasurer-collector as an employee at will for a
- 7 term not to exceed 3 years. The board of selectmen may establish an employment agreement
- 8 with the treasurer-collector for salary, fringe benefits and other conditions of employment,
- 9 including, but not limited to, severance pay, reimbursement for expenses incurred in the
- 10 performance of the duties of the office, liability insurance, and conditions of discipline,

- 11 termination, dismissal, reappointment, performance standards and leave. The position of
- 12 treasurer-collector shall be exempt from the provisions of the town's personnel by-law.
- 13 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding section 1, upon the effective date of this act, the positions of
- 14 elected town treasurer and elected tax collector shall be abolished and the terms of the officers
- 15 holding the office shall be terminated. The board of selectmen shall appoint a treasurer-collector
- 16 in accordance with section 1. A vacancy in the office shall be filled in a like manner for the
- 17 unexpired portion of the term.
- 18 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
