An Act designating a certain bridge in the town of Barre as the Barre American Legion Bridge.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Bridge B-02-005 on Worcester Road, also known as state highway route  
2 122 in the town of Barre shall be designated and known as the Barre American Legion Bridge, in  
3 recognition of the men and women who have proudly served the United States of America. The  
4 Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain a suitable marker bearing  
5 the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
