*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           The department of energy resources, in conjunction with the Massachusetts Development
- 2 Finance Agency, shall develop and implement regulations to establish a residential sustainable
- 3 energy program to provide financing to residential property owners for energy efficient and
- 4 renewable energy improvements.
