An Act regarding net metering.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	Section 1. Section 139 of Chapter 164 as amended by section 5 of chapter 75 of the acts
2	of 2016 is hereby amended by striking the number "7' and inserting in place thereof the
3	following:-"8.75"
4	Section 2. Section 139 of Chapter 164 as amended by section 6 of chapter 75 of the acts
5	of 2016 is hereby amended by striking the number "8" and inserting in place thereof the
6	following:-"10"
7	Section 3. Section 139 of Chapter 164 as appearing in the 2014 official edition is hereby
8	amended by inserting at the end thereof the following new paragraph:-"The secretary of energy

9 and environmental affairs shall every two years review and recommend an increase in the

10 aggregate net metering capacity of facilities that are not of a municipality or other governmental

11 entity and facilities of a municipality or other governmental entity. Said review and

12 recommendation for an increase shall be submitted to the clerks of the house and senate, the joint

- 13 Committee on telecommunications, utilities and energy, and the house and senate committees on
- 14 ways and means."
