## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to state tourism accountability and transparency.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 14 of chapter 23A of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out, in lines 59 and 60, the words "at such time
3	and in such form as the executive director of tourism shall specify", and inserting in place
4	thereof the following:-
5	"on or before October 1 annually, provided, that reports by the regional tourist councils
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6 shall include a list of all municipalities located within said region, and a description of funding

7 directly distributed to or allocated for the promotion of tourism within each municipality"
