Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Chapter 30B Section 1 (b) of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding the following subsection: -
- 3 (35) any contracts or agreements to repair, purchase or commission artistic services,
- 4 works of art, public art, and/or artifacts of a unique or intrinsic artistic character.
- 5 SECTION 2. Chapter 30B Section 2 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 6 Official Edition, is hereby amended, in line 22, by inserting after the word "services" the
- 7 following:-
- 8 "Artistic services", (i) Services provided by an individual or group of
- 9 individuals who profess and practice a skill in the artistic disciplines such as but not
- 10 limited to the visual arts, literary arts, performing arts, craft-based arts, traditional arts,

- textile/fiber arts, design, digital/web based art forms, functional arts, media based arts, and any
- 12 other new or emerging art form.
